PAINTER/SONGWRITER DUO RETURNS TO COMMONWEAL THEATRE

LANESBORO, MN — The Commonweal Theatre Company welcomes the return of artist Zack Jones and singer/songwriter Eddie Elliott on Tuesday, August 16th to the Commonweal Theatre, located in historic, downtown Lanesboro. Presented with support from the Lanesboro Arts Center, the evening begins at 6:30 pm with an art viewing in the Events Hall, and a concert inside the Commonweal Theatre at 7:30 pm.

This partnership began seven years ago in Arizona, and has evolved into several tours traveling back and forth across America showcasing their latest works – including a stop at the Commonweal Theatre back in 2009. From his hometown in Malvern, IA, Zack’s oil paintings celebrate small-town life and landscapes, and are on display in galleries from Iowa to Arizona. Besides Zack, Eddie Elliott has also toured with such acts as Shawn Mullins, David Wilcox, and Richie Havens. His recently released fifth CD - “Come on Down to the House” – features Eddie’s signature soaring vocals amidst lyrics of nostalgia, soul, and hope.
