Thomas White, Commonweal Production Manager, serves as stage manager and leads the production team consisting of designers Kit Mayer (sets), Dietrich Poppen (lights), Jen Brown (costumes), Adrienne Sweeney (props) and Nick Johnston (sound engineer).

The production is underwritten by Four Daughters Vineyard & Winery of Spring Valley and Intermission Restaurant in Lanesboro. Thanks to support from F&M Community Bank special weekday matinee performances are available for school groups at only \$5 per person, which includes a set of enhancement notes, video materials, a pre-show classroom workshop, and a post-performance discussion with the actors.
